Subject: Formulary Changes January 1, 2020 – HIV/AIDS Medications and Lamivudine HBV

Maryland Medicaid has updated their coverage of HIV/AIDS medications; effective January 1, 2020, HIV/AIDS medications will no longer be covered under the Maryland Medicaid Fee for Service program. Instead, these important medications will be covered by Jai Medical Systems as part of our pharmacy benefit.

For Jai Medical Systems members currently receiving treatment, this should not cause any changes in coverage, except that Jai Medical Systems does not currently charge a copay and the pharmacy will need to use the information on the member's Jai Medical Systems insurance card in order to fill the prescription.

Truvada and Descovy will require prior authorization, but any Jai Medical Systems members currently receiving these medications will be automatically given prior authorization through December 31, 2020.

The list of HIV/AIDS medications that will be covered on the Jai Medical Systems formulary starting January 1, 2020 has been attached.

Additionally, Lamivudine HBV 100mg Tablet is being added to the formulary effective January 1, 2020.
